

## VERY LIGHT, DRY, DELICATE WHITE

- 1 Petit Chablis, J. Moreau et Fils £24.15  
France  
Made in classic Chablis style, it is lean and elegant with underlying Chardonnay fruit from the northern tip of Burgundy.

- 2 Footsteps Pinot Grigio, Veneto £14.75  
Italy  
Clean and refreshing very popular grape with light elegant green apples and a gentle floral finish.

## DRY, HERBACEOUS OR AROMATIC WHITE

- 3 Riverstone Ridge Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough £19.75  
New Zealand  
Ripe gooseberry and citrus aromas with herbaceous notes, showing some tropical fruit and lime on the palate.

- 4 Malbrontes Torrontés, Mendoza £19.95  
Argentina  
Shows the typical floral and spice profile that has made Torrontés fashionable recently.

- 5 Footsteps Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley £14.75  
Chile  
Curicó Valley, cooled by the Pacific Ocean creates a racy gooseberry and white peach juiciness.

## JUICY, FRUIT-DRIVEN, RIPE WHITE

Intense, aromatic, tropical fruit flavours spiked with a wedge of orange peel and a sprinkling of baking spice.

A crisp style with a fresh, yet ripe lemon character with no oak ageing.
